

Privacy Notice

Purpose

This Privacy Notice explains how and why your personal data may be used, for how long it may usually be retained for and what are your rights, in line with the applicable data protection legislation. It is important that you read this Privacy Notice together with any other privacy notice we may provide on specific occasions when we are collecting or processing personal data about you so that you are fully aware of how and why we are using your data. This Privacy Notice supplements other notices and privacy policies and is not intended to override them.

This Privacy Notice applies to individuals who visit our website and are at least 18 years of age, and to users who have provided their explicit consent to receive future communication from us, including, but not limited to, newsletters and marketing content.

We reserve the right to update this Privacy Notice at any time, and we may provide you with a new privacy notice when we make any substantial changes. We may also notify you in other ways from time to time about the processing of your personal data.

It is important that the personal data we hold about you is accurate and current. Please keep us informed if your personal data changes during your relationship with us.

For the purpose of this Privacy Notice, Nyree Resources Limited (a British Virgin Islands registered company, registration number, with its registered office at 19 Waterfront Drive, Road Town, VG 1110, Tortola, PO Box 3540, British Virgin Islands) is a Controller of your personal data (collectively referred to as "Exness", "Company", "we", "us" or "our" in this Privacy Notice).

The data we collect about you

Personal data or personal information means any information about an individual from which that person can be identified. It does not include data where the identity has been removed (anonymous data).

If we collect and use personal data about you, the types of data we collect will vary in nature depending on the circumstances and purpose of processing. Here are some illustrative and non-exhaustive examples:

- Personal data about you: name, surname and residential country
- Personal data to contact you: email address
- Personal data from the documentation you provide to us, ie Passport/ID copy (and as applicable), in relation to your data rights
- Consent/permission: such as your consents, any permission or preferences given to the Company.
- Technical Data: such as internet protocol (IP) address, browser type and version, time zone setting and location, browser plug-in types and versions, operating system and platform and other technology on the devices you use to access our website and mobile app and electronic services (as applicable)
- Marketing and Communications Data: such as details about you from email and conversation, and your preference in receiving marketing from us and any third-party companies on our behalf
- Usage Data: such as information about how you use our website and services
- any data we may process in order to handle a data subject request you may submit.

How is your personal data collected?

We will only collect your personal data directly from you and after you provide us with your explicit consent for future communication.

How we use your personal data

Most commonly, we may use personal data in the following circumstances:

- Where it is necessary for our legitimate interests (or those of a third party) and your interests and fundamental rights do not override those interests.
- Where we need to comply with a legal obligation.
- Where we have previously obtained your consent.

By submitting your personal data to us, you acknowledge that you have read and understood the content of this Privacy Notice, you agree to the use of your personal data as set out herein and also confirm that you are at least 18 years of age.

Where we require your consent, such consent shall be freely given by you and you will have the right to withdraw your consent at any time by clicking the unsubscribe link found in every newsletter we send you.

We may use the personal information we collect about you most commonly:

- For future communication to receive Exness insights reports, newsletters and to promote our content, provided you have previously provided your explicit consent for such purpose.
- To respond to your inquiries and deal with any requests you submit regarding your data rights.
- To maintain a suppression list (unsubscribe list) and ensure you do not receive unwanted communications.

Please be aware that this website contains dedicated banners and links through which you may register for an Exness trading account and use Exness products or services. Upon clicking these links, you will be automatically redirected to the appropriate local Exness domain. Following redirection, any account registration, trading activity, or interaction will be governed exclusively by the terms, policies, and regulatory obligations of that local Exness entity. Nyree Resources Limited does not bear responsibility or liability for the content, regulatory status, or service terms of other Exness entities' websites. The redirection is based on your geographic location to ensure you interact with the correct, regulated Exness entity authorized to serve clients in your region. This will also allow us to assess the content most relevant to you ensuring you are contacted about Exness's trading services.

Cookies

You can set your browser to refuse all or some browser cookies. If you disable or refuse cookies, please note that we will not know when you have visited our site, and will not be able to monitor its performance. For more information about the cookies we use, please see our Cookies Policy on the website.

Change of purpose

We may only use your personal data for the purposes for which we collected it, unless we reasonably consider that we need to use it for another reason and that reason is compatible with the original purpose.

If we need to use your personal data for an unrelated purpose, we will notify you and we will explain the legal basis which allows us to do so.

Data sharing

We require all third parties to respect the security of your personal data and to treat it in accordance with the law. We do not allow our third-party service providers to use your personal data for their own purposes and only permit them to process your personal data for specified purposes and in accordance with our instructions. We may share your information with our entities part of the same group of companies, and/or where obliged to do so by an applicable court order and/or where required to do so by an applicable law.

We may outsource the processing of certain functions and/or information to third parties that provide services (acting as data processors) and are involved in the fulfilment of our services to you. Other service providers may include cloud-based software, security, archiving storage, software solution providers, website hosts and website analytics providers, affiliated advertising, and multi-channel marketing and CRM solution, marketing service providers and email marketing platforms.

Please note that the use of your personal information by external third parties who act as data controllers of your personal information is not covered by this Privacy Notice and is not subject to our privacy standards and procedures.

Moreover, our websites may have links to external third-party websites. Please note, however, that third party websites are not covered by this Privacy Notice and those sites are not subject to our privacy standards and procedures. Please check with each third party as to their privacy practices and procedures.

Transfer of data

To the extent we do a cross-border transfer, we will ensure that the transfer is lawful and that there are appropriate safeguards such as standard model clauses or such other methods as may be applicable under relevant data protection laws in place. Moreover, we will ensure that the processors in third countries are obliged to comply with the applicable data protection laws and to provide appropriate safeguards in relation to the transfer of your data in accordance with the provision of the applicable data protection laws.

Data security

We have put in place appropriate security measures to prevent your personal data from being accidentally lost, used or accessed in an unauthorized way, altered or disclosed. In addition, we limit access to your personal data to those employees, agents, contractors and other third parties who have a business need to know. They will only process your personal data on our instructions, and they are subject to a duty of confidentiality. In addition, we train our employees about the importance of confidentiality and maintaining the privacy and security of your information. We have put in place procedures to deal with any suspected personal data breach and will notify you and any applicable regulator of a breach where we are legally required to do so.

Data retention

The Company will process (i.e. collect, store and use) the information you provide in a manner compatible with the applicable data protection legislation. We will endeavor to keep your information accurate and up to date, and not keep it for longer than is necessary. How long certain kinds of personal data should be kept may also be governed by specific business-sector requirements and agreed practices. Personal data may be held in addition to these periods depending on individual business needs and for statistical and historical purposes.

If you have opted out of receiving marketing communications, we will hold your details on our suppression list so that we know you do not want to receive these communications. We may keep your data for longer than the retention period if for legal, regulatory or technical reasons we cannot delete it. In some circumstances we will anonymise your personal data (so that it can no longer be associated with you) for research or statistical purposes.

Your personal data rights

Subject to certain conditions and according to the applicable data protection laws, You may have the right to be informed and/or request from the Company access to and correction/rectification and/or processing restriction and/or erasure of Your personal data and/or to object to processing of Your personal data (e.g. for marketing purposes) as well the right to withdraw consent (where applicable). However, this will not affect the lawfulness of any processing carried out before you withdraw your consent.

These rights are subject to certain rules around when you can exercise them. We may need to request specific information from you to help us confirm your identity. This is a security measure to ensure that personal data is not disclosed to any person who has no right to receive it. Please note that if we are unable to reasonably confirm your identity, we will not be able to honor certain requests. In addition, if you no longer wish to receive our marketing/promotional information you may withdraw your consent to direct marketing at any time directly from the unsubscribe link included in each electronic marketing message we send to you. If you do so, we will update our databases, and will take all reasonable steps to meet your request at the earliest possible opportunity.

Please keep us informed if your personal data changes during your interaction with us.
